1st week	Patients with infection.

5 th week	Patients with endocrine disorders II.
6 th week	Patients with disorders of the immune system.
7 th week	Cancer patients.
8 th week	Patients with nutritional disorders.
9 th week	Patients with diabetes mellitus.
10 th week	Patients with disorders of the digestive system.
11 th week	Patients with urinary system disorders.
12 th week	Patients with addictions.
13 th week	Patients with pain.
Course content – Outline of Tutorial – Laboratory – Clinical Practice	
<p>Clinical practice in clinics and outpatient clinics of public hospitals in the pathology sector. During the clinical practice, the student will participate in the provision of nursing care, under the supervision of clinical nurses. However, she is required to select one patient per week for whom she will create and implement a nursing care plan following her methodology.</p> <p>of the nursing process and which he will also deliver in writing to the person in charge of the clinical exercise.</p>	
1 st week	Selection of a patient with an infection, creating and implementing a nursing plan care.
2 nd week	Selection of a patient with electrolyte and acid-base disturbances balance, creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
3 rd week	Selection of a patient with dermatological disorders, creation and implementation of a plan nursing care.
4 th week	Selecting a patient with an endocrine disorder, creating and implementing a plan nursing care.
5 th week	Selection of a patient with an endocrine disorder (different from the previous one), creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
6 th week	Selecting a patient with a disorder of the immune system, creating and implementation of a nursing care plan.
7 th week	Selecting a patient with cancer, creating and implementing a nursing plan care.
8 th week	Selection of a patient with feeding problems anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, obesity, creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
9 th week	Selecting a patient with diabetes mellitus, creating and implementing a plan nursing care.

10 th week	Selecting a patient with a digestive system disorder, creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
11 th week	Choosing a patient with some urinary system disorder, creating and implementation of a nursing care plan.
12 th week	Selection of a patient with an addiction (alcohol, drugs, internet, gambling), creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
13 th week	Selection of a patient with pain, creating and implementing a nursing care plan.
