Dr Konstantinos Giakoumidakis is an Associate Professor in the Department of Nursing, Faculty of Health Sciences, at the Hellenic Mediterranean University, Heraklion – Crete (Greece). He is a graduate of the Department of Nursing, Faculty of Health Sciences, of the National & Kapodistrian University of Athens – Greece, he holds a master degree (MSc) in Clinical Nursing, and a Ph.D in Nursing, since 2010 (Department of Nursing, Faculty of Health Sciences, National & Kapodistrian University of Athens). Dr Giakoumidakis has taught as a visiting Lecturer, at under and post-graduate university educational level, at the Departments of Nursing in the National & Kapodistrian University of Athens - Greece and the University of Peloponnese – Greece, as also in the European University of Cyprus and the former Piraeus University of Applied Sciences. He had been working as Clinical Registered Nurse for 20 years in Intensive Care Units of public and private tertiary hospitals. His research – writing work includes 55 peer-reviewed international journals' publications and 15 peer-reviewed hellenic journals' publications with h-index of 17 and more than 760 citations (Google Scholar). Additionally, he has 38 publications to abstract books and 17 chapters in Books.
